  - RoboBoat, RoboSub, RobotX






- Launched in 1997 (26 years ago)






### 2023 Competition


### **COMPETITION**




### **DESTINATION - GATE**






### **START DIALING - BUOY**

Square: 4ft x 4ft (1.2m x 1.2m)






### **LOCATION - BINS**






### **GOA'ULD ATTACK - TORPEDOES**





